

408.00 CORRUPTION PREVENTION

408.01 Corruption: Acts involving the misuse of authority by a police officer in a manner designed to produce personal gain for himself or others.

408.02 Policy:

It is the policy of the Greeley Police Department to establish measures designed to prevent corruption and to investigate and prosecute corruption to the full extent of the law and administrative authority, when reported or identified.

Organizational philosophy, values, and goals: The Greeley Police Department will maintain and periodically review and revise, if necessary, a statement of philosophy and values that explicitly states the goals, values, and general philosophic approach to policing by this department. This statement will be entitled "Statement of Goals" and will include the department's mission statement. Supervisors will periodically review this statement with their employees.

Code of Ethics: The Greeley Police Department will maintain and periodically review and revise, as necessary, a Code of Ethics. This code will be incorporated into General Order Chapter 400. Each employee will be issued a copy of this directive, required to read it and sign the signature page at the end of the chapter indicating that the employee has read and understands it.

Code of Conduct: The Code of Conduct is incorporated into General Order 400. New employees will receive a copy of and be instructed in its contents. The Code of Conduct will be reviewed annually for relevance, timeliness, adequacy and completeness. This review will be conducted and coordinated by the Professional Standards Unit with a review committee appointed by the Chief of Police.
