

**525.00 CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS OF CITIZENS**

- All personnel will comply strictly with constitutional requirements during criminal investigations. These requirements include, but are not limited to:
  - All arrests will be based on probable cause or will be made under authority of an arrest warrant.
  - Intrusions into an individual's private conversation or correspondence will be covered by a search warrant.
  - Only physical force that is necessary and proper will be used at any time.
  - Search and seizures of persons and property will be made according to law.
  - Officers will ensure the physical safety of arrested persons.
  - Confessions and/or admissions must be voluntarily given, and will not be obtained by coercion or by any other illegal means.
  - Arrested persons will be allowed to notify relatives or others of their whereabouts, will be allowed to confer with an attorney, and will be transported within a reasonable time to a detention facility or to a magistrate to prevent any delay in arraignment.
