

552.00 USE OF POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES

- All Police Department personnel are prohibited from driving a police vehicle, including a motorcycle, outside Greeley City Limits unless they are on-duty and engaged in an on-duty activity that requires them to be outside City Limits. The only exception to this rule is the below regarding Weld County Drug Task Force.
- Personnel are not authorized to transport family members or friends in a police vehicle while on-duty or off-duty. The only persons authorized as passengers in police vehicles at any time are other City employees, authorized ride-alongs, and those persons who need to be transported or placed inside a police vehicle in connection with on-duty activities.
- Personnel who reside inside the City Limits of Greeley who are on call on a 24-hour basis and are assigned a home storage vehicle and those personnel who are assigned a police vehicle while temporarily on-call, will not drive those vehicles outside the City Limits of Greeley while off-duty.
- Personnel who reside outside the City Limits of Greeley will not be assigned a home storage vehicle or motorcycle regardless of their permanent or temporary on-call status.
- Weld County Drug Task Force personnel, even if they reside outside the City Limits of Greeley, because they are frequently called to immediately respond to locations throughout Weld County, may be authorized a home storage vehicle by a Task Force Supervisor; but they are not authorized to have any person, including family members or friends, in the assigned vehicle unless that person is in the vehicle in connection with an on-duty activity.
- The Chief of Police's access to vehicles is controlled by contract and allows the transport of family members in City vehicles anywhere in Colorado.
