553.00 MULTIPLE UNITS RESPONSE CALLS

553.01 Types of Multiple Unit Calls

- The calls on which either two single-officer units or a single two-officer unit will routinely respond to include:
 - Disturbance;
 - Loud Party;
 - Drunk;
 - DUI – stop;
 - Accident Unknown injuries;
 - Burglary and Robbery Alarms;
 - Prowler;
 - Stabbing;
 - Fight;
 - Disturbance;
 - Shooting/shots fired;
 - Open door/building/window;
 - Suspicious person/activity; and
 - Any “emergency/in-progress/officer hazard call.”

- All other calls may be single officer units unless circumstances indicate a need for more than one officer.
- A patrol supervisor or an officer may alter these guidelines and assign additional units or respond as situations dictate.
- A supervisor will respond to calls of armed robbery, rape, homicide, burglar in a building, fire where hoses are laid, assist an injured officer, mentally disturbed or suicidal person, other calls of a major or unusual nature, arrests, or to calls where the supervisor’s presence is requested by the officer.
