108.00 ACCOUNTABILITY

108.01 Policy:


- Assigned responsibility will be accompanied by commensurate authority.
- To promote efficiency and the concept of unity of command, employees will be held accountable to only one supervisor at any given time.
- Each employee will be held accountable for his use of delegated authority.

108.02 Supervisory Accountability: Supervisory personnel are accountable for the actions of the employees operating under their immediate supervision. Commensurate with this responsibility, the span of control of supervisory personnel will be limited. The following restrictions limiting the span of control are:

- Chief of Police: three to seven employees.
- Deputy Chief of Police: three to seven employees.
- Police Commander: three to seven employees.
- Police Sergeant: seven to twelve employees.
- Records Supervisor: seven to twelve employees.
- Evidence Supervisor: three to seven employees.

108.03 Lawful Orders:

Officers will comply with lawful orders issued by a supervisor or relayed by a subordinate from a superior as directed by the Code of Conduct, Chapter V, Article 5.6. If an officer is confronted with a conflicting order, he/she will comply with the Code of Conduct, Chapter V, Article 5.7.
