



374.00 RECRUIT TRAINING

- The recruit training program at the Police Department incorporates three organizational components. These phases are:
 - Attendance and completion of a State of Colorado certified training academy,
 - Attendance and completion of an “in-house”, departmentally sponsored in-service training program to supplement the certified academy, and
 - Attendance and completion of a field training program.
- The Training Sergeant will coordinate and administer the recruit’s involvement in the first two phases and ensure the following:
 - Curriculum is developed and based upon job-task analyses of the most frequent assignment of officers who complete recruit training; and
 - That evaluation techniques are designed to measure competency in the required skills, knowledge and abilities.
- Field Training for new police officers shall be coordinated and supervised by the Operations Deputy Chief or his designee.
- All newly sworn officers will complete a State of Colorado certified training academy prior to being assigned to any position within the Department which would allow them to carry a firearm or evoke powers of arrest without supervision, except as part of a formal field training program.
