**386.00 TRAINING OF FIELD TRAINING OFFICERS**

- The officer chosen to be a Field Training Officer will receive in-service training by the Greeley Police Department and be sent to a 40 hour field training officer seminar. The purpose of the training will be to familiarize the field-training officer with training techniques and evaluation methods and criteria.
- The minimum completed training will include the following:
  - The Field Training Officer as a role model;
  - Teaching Skills;
  - The evaluation process;
  - Special training issues: minorities and women;
  - Communicating effectively;
  - Leadership style and motivation of the recruiting officer;
  - Creating the learning climate; and
  - Remediating deficiencies.
- At the conclusion of an active field training cycle, the Field Training Sergeant(s) will conduct an evaluation on each officer involved in training a recruit.
- While his/her skills as an evaluator are important, the Field Training Officer's primary responsibility is to teach.
