**509.00 ARRESTS REQUIRING SPECIAL HANDLING**

- Arrests of an officer, special officer, or a private guard.
  - Any arrest involving an officer, a special officer, or a private guard will be noted on the arrest report.
  - Any person searching a prisoner and finding a permit, officer or special officer identification will make a note of same in his report and immediately notify a supervisor. A copy of any report noting an arrest of an officer, a special officer, or private guard will be forwarded to the appropriate Deputy Chief
  - If an elected official or sworn officer of any jurisdiction is arrested, the appropriate Deputy Chief will be notified immediately.
- When a prisoner who is under arrest for a felony is taken to the hospital and admitted, and it appears that the prisoner would constitute a danger to the community or presents an escape risk if left unguarded, a guard will be placed with the prisoner until the prisoner is transferred to the custody of another agency. A Watch Commander or On-Call Command will be notified prior to commencing the guarding of a prisoner. Foreign Nationals with or without visa:
  - On the arrest of a foreign national, the investigating officer will note on the arrest sheet and in his report that the subject is a foreign national and notify the jail booking technician.
  - Notification to the Department of Homeland Security Immigration and Customs Enforcement will typically be made by jail personnel.
