525.00 CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS OF CITIZENS

- All personnel will comply strictly with constitutional requirements during criminal investigations. These requirements include, but are not limited to:
 - All arrests will be based on probable cause or will be made under authority of an arrest warrant.
 - Any intrusions into an individual's private conversation or correspondence will be authorized by a search warrant.
 - Only physical force that is necessary and proper will be used at any time.
 - Search and seizures of persons and property will be made according to law.
 - Officers will ensure the physical safety of arrested persons.
 - Confessions and/or admissions must be voluntarily given, and will not be obtained through coercion or by any other illegal means.
 - Provided the opportunity to notify relatives or others of their whereabouts. If the arrested person requests to confer with an attorney, he or she will be allowed to do so. Arrested persons will be transported within a reasonable time to a detention facility or to a magistrate to prevent any delay in arraignment.
