**526.00 JUSTICE/SOCIAL DIVERSION PROGRAMS**

- There are often social service diversion programs in which law enforcement agencies are directly involved, including detoxification, mental health, and drug abuse diversion programs. It will be the policy of the Greeley Police Department to interact with these programs and agencies through program participation and by providing personnel to serve as directors, advisors, or committee members.
- Pursuant to this policy, the Chief of Police or his designee will seek appointment on committees or advisory boards.
- In addition, the Chief of Police or his designee will participate in any other criminal justice or social service diversion programs which directly affect the department, or enhance partnerships with these outside organizations.
