



552.00 USE OF POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES

- Unless authorized, all Police Department personnel are prohibited from driving a police vehicle, including a motorcycle, outside Greeley City Limits unless they are on-duty and engaged in an on-duty activity that requires them to be outside City Limits.
- Unless authorized, personnel are not authorized to transport family members or friends in a police vehicle while on-duty or off-duty. Unless authorized, the only persons authorized as passengers in police vehicles at any time are other City employees, authorized ride-alongs, and those persons who need to be transported or placed inside a police vehicle in connection with on-duty activities.
- Unless authorized, personnel who reside inside the city limits of Greeley who are on call on a 24-hour basis and are assigned a take home vehicle and those personnel who are assigned a police vehicle while temporarily on-call, will not drive those vehicles outside the City Limits of Greeley while off-duty.
- Weld County Drug Task Force (WCDF) personnel are exempt from this directive and authorization for WCDF vehicle use is upon approval and direction of the WCDF Commander.
- The Chief of Police’s access to vehicles is controlled by contract and as such, is exempt from this directive.
